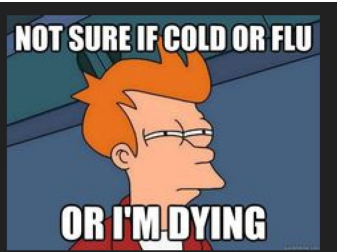
In Islam, Muhammad is believed to be the last prophet of God

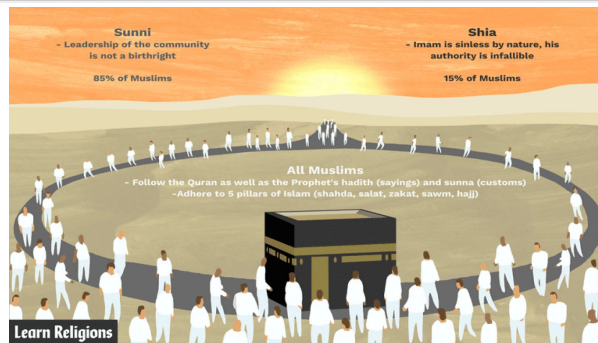
Death of Muhammad

 - However, it quickly splits after his death.



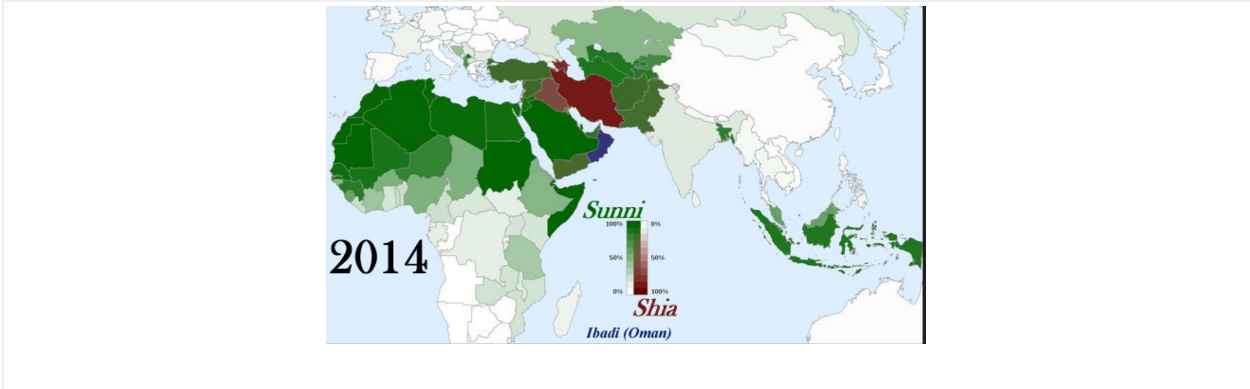
